Replacing Batteries

Pooltest 9 Prof, Premier, Pooltest 25 Prof, +, Photometer 7100, 7500

The battery compartment in the base of the instrument is secured by four screws.

To replace the batteries, remove the cover and install the batteries, observing the correct polarity as indicated.

Use 3 of the same brand x 1.5V 'AA' Alkaline batteries. Do not use rechargeable/lithium batteries.

To avoid corrosion damage through leakage, remove batteries from the instrument if it is to be stored or left unused for a long period of time.

Pooltest 9 Premier, 25 and Photometer 7500

When either of these units above are connected to the computer, the batteries **must be taken out** as the power is generated by the computer.
